Well, here we are again starting a New Assembly Year for the Good Shepherd Assembly. It's been a Hot and Humid Summer, and hopefully we can have a nice fall to enjoy.

In reflecting on the past year or so, many changes have taken place in our Assembly. A number of members transferred away to form a new Assembly at Epiphany. We moved from Mass and Dinners at Fridley Knights of Columbus Hall to St. John the Baptist church, and now to our new home at Immaculate Conception and Church of St. Joseph in Lino Lakes. We have recruited 17 new members into our Assembly in the past two years, but because of the transfers, we are still at a membership of 99 members. I hope we can continue recruitment of a 10% increase or more this year, as we see many new 3<sup>rd</sup> degree Councils in the area.

We have just had our Yearly Assembly Audit and our Yearly Officers meeting to go over our standing and to review the budget for 2011-2012. Although the Assembly is in good shape financially this year, we still need additional funds for any charitable donations, etc.

The fall 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Exemplification will be held in Willmar Mn. on Sept. 24, 2011. We have one new recruit so far from St. Joseph who will join us at this exemplification. Start now in recruiting new members for the Spring Exemplification, which is in St. Cloud, Mn on April 21, 2012. Because we are Hosting the Fall 2012 Exemplification, we will need to promote our exemplification, with whatever the Assembly chooses for promotional items, at the Spring Exemplification.

I look forward to working with all Officers and Members of the Good Shepherd Assembly, and ask for your prayers as we move forward into the Assembly Year!!

#### Faithful Captain's Report


