The Assembly voted to keep the name the "Good Shepherd" Assembly. The Epiphany council has renamed there council to the Father Reiser Council.

We covered a lot of other business during our "short" business meeting. Delegates were elected to attend the Biennial meeting scheduled for April 20th 2012 in St. Cloud, Mn. (See Below) The Faithful Navigator Richard Jacobson and the Faithful Admiral Patrick Shannon, will represent the Good Shepherd Assembly, at this meeting, with the Faithful Captain Robert Peterson as the alternate.

"Article V, Section 14 of the Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree of The Knights of Columbus dated July 2001 requires that a Biennial Meeting of the District be held during the months of March or April in the even numbered years.

The Delegates of each Assembly shall be composed of the Faithful Navigator of each Assembly in the District and one delegate for each one hundred members or major fraction thereof of each Assembly which Delegates shall be elected by ballot at the February meeting. Assemblies shall have the right to elect alternates for the Faithful Navigator and for any delegates to which they may be entitled. "

Further business was approved for Funds to be released to the District Master of MN Robert Mathewson, for the Assembly's contribution to the District Fund for Promotional work. Also contributions were approved for the Fort St. Charles Fund that we donate to each year. Both of these contributions are a budgeted item for the Assembly each year.
