## Good Shepherd Assembly Meeting Minutes May 13, 2013

- The May Business Meeting was convened at 7:01 PM with the Opening Ode, Pledge of Allegiance and prayer. All officers with the exceptions of Faithful Friar Fr. John Mitchell and Faithful Inner Sentinel Terry Meyer were present.
- Faithful Navigator Robert Peterson announced that five new Sir Knights had joined our Assembly at the 4<sup>th</sup> degree Spring Exemplification.
- Minutes from our April meeting at 7:15 PM were read, corrected and approved.
- Bills and a motion to pay them was made and passed, along with balances and finances.
- SK Alan Savage presented an update for the Bylaws Committee. Voting to accept the finalized proposal for review (not ratification) will need to wait until the Committee has finished its drafting efforts at a later date.
- Faithful Navigator Robert Peterson stated that the current Chalice (now lacking room for any further inscribed names) will be given to a missionary.
- Faithful Comptroller Robert Peltier reported that the Roster Committee lacks only the email addresses of a few new members.
- Faithful Trustee 3 Year Patrick Shannon reported on the proposals from the Charitable Giving Committee. Among the proposals was a focus on Catholic charities for donations that was later amended to include Patriotic causes. Also proposed was a raise of the fund limit for donations which will require an update to the Bylaws. Motion to accept the proposals was made and passed.
- Faithful Admiral Richard Jacobson presented an update for the Fund Raiser Committee. The Annual Golfing Event flyers were widely dispersed but not been much response yet. The post event banquet will be a steak dinner at Epiphany Church. A Skeet Shoot Event at the Metro Gun Club is in the planning for the Fall. The possibility of a Bowling Event for late Fall or early Winter is also under investigation.
- Faithful Scribe Sean Welch presented a proposal from the Web Page Committee and recommended upgrades to the current service. Motion to accept was made and passed.
- The Admissions Committed reported one St. Charles transfer into the Assembly from the Nicollet Assembly.
