Mass was celebrated by Faithful Friar John Mitchell at Immaculate Conception Church. Mass commenced at 6:00 PM and concluded at 6:30 PM. Faithful Friar John Mitchell led us in prayer at 6:53 PM before we enjoyed another wonderful meal.

Faithful Captain Marc Peters began the after dinner activities at 7:27 PM by requesting an introduction from all new members and spouses. He requested wedding anniversary information and also let us know that the deadline for December 10th dinner reservations are required no later than Thursday November 29th. He then thanked the Assembly for a great job hosting the 2012 Fall Exemplification and acknowledged a sizeable list of key participants.
